

**Notice regarding the English proficiency evaluation
for the entrance examination conducted in the winter of FY2020 (January 2021)**

In the entrance examinations for the Department of Genetics, it is required to submit a score of one of the designated English proficiency evaluation tests. In view of the influence of the spread of new coronavirus infection, for the entrance examination conducted in the winter of FY2020 (January 2021), the following changes will apply.

How to Submit a Score	Submit a copy at the time of application and bring the original on the day of the entrance examination. On the day of the entrance examination, the original will be confirmed and returned to the applicant. (For the TOEFL iBT Test, you may arrange the score directly sent from ETS to SOKENDAI. In this case, you do not need to bring the original on the day of the entrance examination.)	Submit the original at the time of application. (For the TOEFL iBT Test, you may arrange the score directly sent from ETS to SOKENDAI. In this case, you do not need to submit the original at the time of application.) If the original cannot be submitted at the time of application, the original must reach SOKENDAI (in Hayama) by mail strictly by Tuesday January 26, 2021. (In this case, please write so in Attached Form 9 of Application Forms.) The original will be confirmed and returned to the applicant by mail.
